



Wine on Tap is set to revolutionise wine by the glass in the UK. Wine is stored in a high-tech bag housed in a keg that mimics winery conditions, savings are made on packaging that are instead spent on better wine – and when the keg is finished, it goes out with our recycling meaning that we're much kinder to the environment. We've found that wines from a keg taste brighter and fresher than in a bottle and they represent extraordinary value for money. We have access to a growing range of wines from around the world, including unusual varieties that you might be trying for the first time like Anto Vaz and Zweigelt, so expect new and interesting additions to our line-up from one week to the next.

## CORAVIN



This system allows us to take wine from the bottle without ever removing the cork! Once a glass of wine is poured, the bottle is then flushed with argon gas, which preserves the remaining wine until the next glass is required, almost indefinitely. We are using this unique wine preservation system to offer a changing range of fine wines by the glass at Grain Store.
